ATG Donate \$40,000



In celebration of its 40th anniversary this year, Attorneys' Title Guaranty Fund, Inc. (ATG) announced it will donate a total of \$40,000 to four not-for-profit organizations that serve the legal community, including the Harold I. Levine Center for Housing in Chicago. Peter J. Harold Levine was a longtime ATG member and ardent supporter who brought enthusiasm and insight into the practice of real estate law. Over the years, he devoted thousands of pro bono hours to indigent defendants, particularly in housing-related matters.
