Retirements

McDonald retires from Attorneys' Title. Ward F. McDonald of Mahomet has retired from Attorneys' Title Guaranty Fund, where he had served as former leader, board member and board chairman.

McDonald worked for ATG first as a law clerk, then in the company's top position as executive vice president. After leaving ATG to return to the private practice of law, he served on the ATG board of directors and various committees.

He served as board chairman during the organization's 50th anniversary in 2014, then announced his retirement from the board in January.

The retirement news came on the heels of ATG's annual donation to the Ward F. McDonald Scholarship Fund at the University of Illinois College of Law. ATG established the scholarship in 2010 to honor McDonald when he celebrated his 40th year in the practice of law.
